What is the AGCAS Alumni Network?

The AGCAS Alumni Network consists of Retired Affiliates who wish to remain in touch with each other and with what is happening in HE careers services and across the sector.

The purpose of the Alumni Network is to reinforce the strong network of links between Retired Affiliates and facilitate engagement between current AGCAS members and Retired Affiliates to enable the strengthening of the corporate experience.

In addition to a dedicated area on the AGCAS website, the Alumni Network now has a JISCMail discussion list to help keep members in touch and informed. In addition, it holds annual reunions with excellent opportunities for members to socialise and have fun, as well as receive updates on developments.
